... A Ballet Scholarship Program for male dancers and athletes

This Fall, Destiny Dance Institute is excited to launch *Boys Dance Too*, a Scholarship Program exclusively for boys, ages 8-12, who are interested in exploring the art of ballet. Whether it is an artistic pursuit or to supplement athletic performance, participants are sure to come away with a variety of new skills: increased flexibility, agility, coordination and balance, strength, focus, self-discipline, creativity and self-confidence. As in any sport, male dancers must be willing to work hard to achieve enhanced performance and heightened physicality. The men's class will be taught by one of our highly qualified male instructors, so boys should feel right at home in the studio.

Program includes:

- Full tuition scholarship for 2 ballet technique classes weekly: One male technique class taught by a male instructor + one co-ed class in an appropriate level.
- Dancer will undergo an assessment after the first 8-weeks to determine continued eligibility.
- Opportunity to audition for and to perform with the Wake Forest Civic Ballet

Program commitments:

- Dancers invited to perform would do so under the provisions set forth in the Wake Forest Civic Ballet Company Contract, to include all company fees.
- Dancers must adhere to the boys class dress codes as set forth on our website.
- Dancers will be expected to attend classes regularly or DDI reserves the right to revoke the scholarship
- Dancers must be attentive, respectful and supportive of fellow students, parents, faculty and staff.
- Dancers will commit to taking classes exclusively at DDI, and may not perform for any other school or non-profit company without permission from the DDI Director of Ballet Programs for the duration of the contract.
